VDA 6.8 for VDA 6.3 Process Auditors

1. Contents:

This training provides the fundamentals for process audits in the supply chain according to VDA 6.8, considering the process-oriented approach and risk analysis in the automotive industry.

You will learn which requirements are relevant for the different areas including project management, planning/implementation, supplier management, procurement, transport, production and warehouse logistics, as well as customer management, and how these can be realized in concrete terms.

2. Objectives:

- a) Understanding the general requirements and principles of VDA 6.8.
Applying the questionnaire in practice
- b) using the process elements (L1–L7).

3. Concept and Methods:

The training alternates between selected theoretical content and practical exercises.

4. Target Audience:

VDA 6.3 Process Auditors with professional experience in logistics who want to conduct audits according to VDA 6.8 in the future.

5. Prerequisites for Attendance:

Certificate of qualification or certificate VDA 6.3:2023

Target qualification: Internal process auditors

- a) Advanced knowledge of supply-chain processes, concepts and the associated risks (e.g. FMEA, turtle).
- b) Proficiency in the application logistical IT solutions (software, hardware and hosting)
- c) Knowledge of quality tools and methods (e.g. 8D, 5W, Ishikawa, PDCA).
- d) Auditor qualification knowledge based on ISO 19011 (e.g. negotiation, conflict management, audit procedure, audit documents).
- f) Knowledge of the relevant management system requirements (e.g. ISO 9001, VDA 6.2).
- g) Knowledge of the relevant customer-specific requirements.
- h) At least three years of professional experience, of which at least one year should be in logistics-related activities.

Target qualification: Supplier auditors

- a) Advanced knowledge of supply-chain processes, concepts and the associated risks (e.g. FMEA, turtle).
- b) Proficiency in the application logistical IT solutions (software, hardware and hosting)
- c) Knowledge of Global MMOG/LE and VDA 6.8
Good command of quality tools and methods (e.g. 8D, 5W, Ishikawa, PDCA).
- d) Auditor qualifications (negotiation, conflict management, audit procedure, audit documents).
- f) Knowledge of the relevant management system requirements (e.g. ISO 9001, VDA 6.2).

5. Prerequisites for Attendance (Cont.):

Target qualification: Supplier auditors

- g) Knowledge of the relevant customer-specific requirements.
- h) At least five years of professional experience in an industrial company, of which at least two years should be in logistics-related areas of activity.

1 day (8 hours).

7. Certificate of Qualification:

After passing the knowledge test (Single-Choice-Test), you will receive a certificate of qualification.
